



Paris 2024 Policy for its sustainability and legacy management system

Since the bid phase, Paris 2024 has been committed to deliver **revolutionary, spectacular and sustainable Games**. Sustainability and legacy are at the heart of the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games ambitious project, which was developed in collaboration with athletes and the sports movement, public authorities, civil society and all the stakeholders of the Games ecosystem.

Paris 2024 Games constitute a common horizon to take up the social and environmental challenges the world is facing. With this deeply rooted belief, Paris 2024, in alignment with the IOC Agenda 2020 and in alignment with the UN Sustainable Development Goals, is committed to organize Olympic and Paralympic Games of a new era; Games that contribute to the ecological and social transformation of the society.

This strong double ambition, environmental and social, is integrated from the design and planning phases to the Games delivery and beyond, to the post-event activities: **in all these steps, Paris 2024 aims to leave a positive legacy** and to keep these ambitions alive beyond the Games. This ambition is defined through challenges matching the sustainability issues identified as priorities for the activities that fall into Paris 2024's perimeter:

- Be exemplary and innovative in environmental matters by delivering **carbon neutral Games**; preserving and regenerating **biodiversity**; developing a **circular economy**; building **environmental resilience** and contributing to the acceleration of the sport, territories and major events **ecological transformation**.
- Organize Games that drive **social and economic development** for the host territories and improve their quality of life for as many people as possible; that support **inclusion, equality, solidarity**, the fight against racism and stereotypes; and that **strengthens the role of sport in society**.
- Mobilize the "Generation 2024" to **accelerate society transformation through education** and citizen engagement, by and through sport.
- Integrate universal **accessibility in an exemplary way as early as the Games conception**, with the aim of ensuring an inclusive experience for all and leaving a material and immaterial legacy.

In addition, in accordance with its mission and values, Paris 2024 affirms its commitment to **implement the duty of vigilance, integrity, transparency and inclusion; to respect all legal and other requirements** that apply to its activities; and to **work closely with its suppliers through sustainable sourcing and purchasing practices.**

Finally, to reach those goals, **Paris 2024 is committed to developing all its activities through a sustainable management system in compliance with the ISO 20121 international norm.** Within this framework, Paris 2024 has the will to further develop practices in the field of sustainable event management and is working to persistently improve its performances in this matter.
