

WELCOME TO THE PARIS 2024 OLYMPIC CLOSING CEREMONY

GAMES OVER!

The Paris 2024 Olympic Games are drawing to a close, and it is with immense pride, and gratitude in our hearts, that we prepare to conclude this global event. These Games have been marked by moments of glory, of exceptional achievement and of solidarity between athletes from all over the world, and the time has come to celebrate all the heroes who have emerged and mark the end of this extraordinary adventure.

CELEBRATING THE ATHLETES BACK AT THE STADIUM

As competition draws to a close, all eyes return to the Stade de France in Saint-Denis, where much of the action has taken place, the sense of excitement still ringing in the air, for a unique opportunity to bring all the participants together one last time to take part in what promises to be a true spectacle in the middle of the ceremony. As a theatre and opera director, I have harnessed the stadium setting using the tools we commonly see in live performance - lighting, sets, costumes, scenography, etc. - to create a unique celebration of the Paris 2024 Games.

A BRAND-NEW SHOW BASED ON THE ORIGINS OF THE OLYMPIC GAMES

In 884 BC, in the midst of an outbreak of plague and with wars ravaging his kingdom, Iphitos, King of Elis, was intent on appeasing the anger of the gods. He consulted the oracle at Delphi and was advised to create the Olympic Games. The Games have therefore embodied these healing values we have come to know as the "Olympic Spirit", and the peace and healing associated with them, since ancient times. This true spectacle will take us on a dystopian, dreamlike journey back to the foundations of humanity in a tribute to the creation of the Games and their revival by Pierre de Coubertin, father of the modern Olympic Games, in the late 19th century.


A MINDFUL CELEBRATION 19




CLOSING CEREMONY AT THE STADE DE FRANCE

Click on one of your sessions to discover the different tickets.






Open your tickets by clicking on one of them. A secure QR code will be displayed as you approach the event and will be available offline.



POCKET-SIZED TICKET FRQ



A secure QR code will be displayed on your ticket in the application, as the event approaches, to enable you to access the ceremony venue. Activation of this QR code is automatic and does not require an internet connection. It is essential to log in beforehand with your Paris 2024 login details.



What should I do if my phone battery runs out during a ticket check?

It is your responsibility to ensure that your smartphone has sufficient battery power to present your digital ticket on the "Paris 2024 Tickets" application at the competition site access control. We invite you to prepare your visit carefully and to take the necessary precautions.

Your ticket is for sale!
If it is sold, you will be notified. If not, you can withdraw it at any time directly from the official resale platform.

If your ticket has been transferred to you by a specific entity or if it is part of hospitality offer, the resale is not possible.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

STADE DE FRANCE SAINT-DENIS





Then 900 metres walk to the venue






Then 300 m walk to the venue

Take the REP D or metro line M 4 to reach the Stade de France.

It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site as soon as the gates open at 6:00pm.





ACTIVE MOBILITY

Four free bicycle parking zones, are available to spectators on the day of the event:


- → 16 Boulevard Anatole France 93 200 Saint-Denis
- → Cours du Ru de Montfort, Cité du Franc Moisin -93 200 Saint-Denis
- → Rue Ahmed Boughera el Ouafi 93 200 Saint-Denis
- → 221 Avenue du président Wilson 93 200 Saint-Denis

Bicycles helmets, electric batteries and other equipment are prohibited within the competition venue and must be left at the parking zone. Paris 2024 may not be held liable for any theft or damage.

PARK-AND-RIDE **FACILITIES**

Motorised vehicles (cars, motorbikes, etc.) are not authorised to park within the vicinity of the competition venue but park and ride facilities are available.

Book your car park close to public transport links to the competition venues.





TRAVEL OPTIONS



SHUTTLE BUSES FOR WHEELCHAIR SPECTATORS

A dedicated transport service for spectators with a accessible or wheelchair ticket and their accompanying person will be provided to reach each of the competition venues for the Paris 2024 Games from several stations in Paris. This service is only accessible with early booking, possible up to 48 hours before the start of your session.

Spectators with disabilities are advised to use this service in light of the expected high number of travellers on public transport networks.

MOTOR VEHICLE

A drop-off zone for disabled spectators is available at 2 Rue Jesse Owens (93200 Saint-Denis). Parking spaces for wheelchair users can be found at Rue de la Couture Saint-Quentin (93200 Saint-Denis).

Public transport accessibility



From the accessible shuttle drop-off zone and from the wheelchair parking, spectators with disabilities will be accompanied to the venue entrance.

ON-SITE ARRIVAL



People with disabilities or with specific needs will be greeted on site by Paris 2024 volunteers. This service notably includes priority access to the venue, mobility assistance, the provision of hearing assistance, as well a dog-friendly area. Full details of this service can be found at the Information Desk which can be located using the interactive map available on the following page.



NO LOCKERS ON SITE

Please bring only essential items. Any prohibited items shall be confiscated and will not be returned on exit.



ATMs

For payments onsite, we accept only Visa card and mobile payments, along with cash.



SMOKING BAN

Smoking and vaping are prohibited throughout the venue.



WASTE SORTING

Recycling bins are available at the competition venue.



A selection of products for all tastes can be found at the food and beverage concessions to provide delicious, more local and more plant-based nutrition. This selection is accompanied by a choice of non-alcoholic drinks.



Head to one of the official stores at the venue to pick up your own Paris 2024 Olympic souvenirs.



Fountains with drinking water are available free of charge at the venue. Remember to bring a metal or plastic bottle, 75 cl maximum, with you (glass is prohibited).



Make the most of the entertainment provided to add to the festive experience with the activities offered by Intel-Samsung and Samsung.



VOLUNTEERS

Our volunteers (Paris 2024 and host cities) are available to help from start to finish. We're counting on you to make sure their contribution is recognised.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

If you require assistance, look for a medical station or a person wearing a red bib. Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) are installed at the venue and are freely accessible.

PLAN YOUR ARRIVAL

ON THE DAY

ONCE THE SESSION IS FINISHED

THERE ARE NO LOCKERS ON SITE.

Make sure to take the bare minimum to make the access control process as smooth as possible.

Prohibited items will be confiscated and not returned on exit.

In addition to the standard safety checks, a systematic check of liquids is planned.



ONCE THE SESSION IS FINISHED



Check that your phone is charged and that you've downloaded the necessary apps:

- "Paris 2024 Tickets" app
- Paris 2024 Official app
- "Public Transport Paris 2024" app



Check the weather forecast and plan accordingly (wide-rimmed hat, sun cream, sun glasses, foldable small umbrella, water bottle, etc.). For more information on prevention measures, see here.



Use public transport or active mobility modes. Make sure you have a valid transport ticket for the outward and return journey and check traffic conditions.

Plan to arrive as soon as the gates open at 6:00 pm.

Entrance is closed 30 minutes before the end of the ceremony.

> Any exit from the venue is final.


